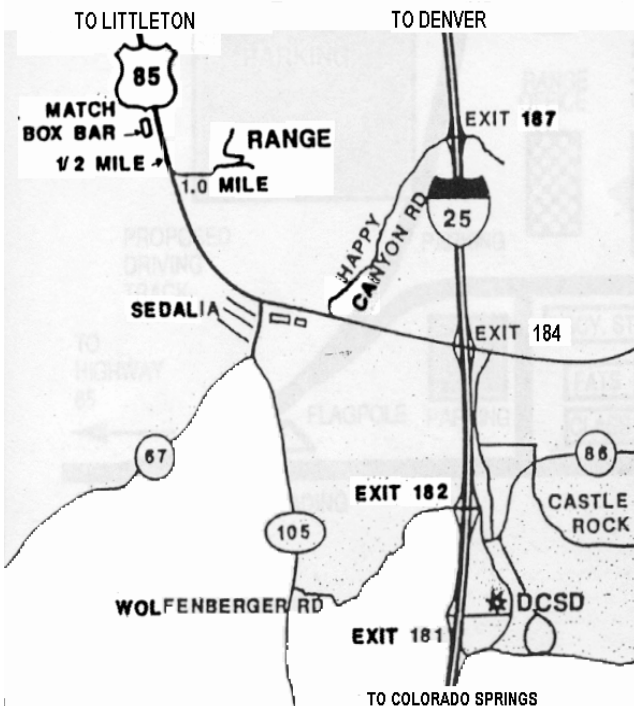


## Directions to the Shooting Range

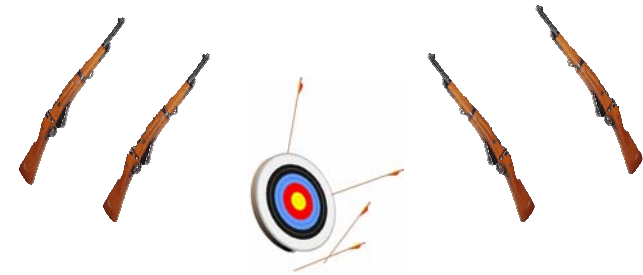

## Event Rules

- All currently enrolled 4-H members ages 8-18 are welcome to attend. You must have a hunter safety card. You do not have to be enrolled in the shooting sports project to participate.
- Maximum of 70 participants.
- One younger member and one older member will be randomly selected as teammates before the event. We will determine the age break after registrations are received.
- Team members may be from different counties. Teams will be paired younger/older.
- Each team will participate in the following 7 stations:
  - Muzzleloading (25 Yards)
  - Shotgun—Trap (Buddy Shoot)
  - .22 Rifle Hunt
  - Archery—Recurve (20 yards)
  - Air Pistol
  - Orienteering
  - Shooting Sports Knowledge Quiz
- Only five teams will be allowed at a station at one time. All 7 stations will be running simultaneously.
- Each team will be given a check card to keep track of what stations they have been to. Teams will decide which station they want to go to first.
- Targets/Score cards will be collected by officials after each round and given to score table.
- All shooting range safety rules will be strictly followed. Anyone being unsafe will be asked to leave the event immediately, forfeiting all awards.

## Education

A main component of this regional shoot is education. We want all participants to have a great time, get a little practice in and learn something while they are at it. That is why this will be a one-of-a-kind invitational shoot. Teams will compete in seven different discipline areas for top honors. Teams will consist of one younger member and one older member, randomly selected before the shoot. This will be your team for the entire event. Together you will participate in each station receiving a combined score. This will be a great mentoring opportunity for all ages. Participants will also get the opportunity to try different disciplines that they may not otherwise be able to.

## Prizes

- 1st—6th place team ribbons will be awarded for each station.
- 1st—6th place team rosettes will be awarded for the overall combination scores of all 7 stations.
- The overall champion team members will each receive a \$50 gift certificate to Bass Pro Shop.
- The overall reserve champion team members will each receive a \$25 gift certificate to Bass Pro Shop.

## What to bring

- Appropriate clothing for time of year and shooting gear
- Eye & ear protection
- Water -A concession stand will also be open!

## DO NOT BRING

- Do NOT bring your own fire arms, bows or ammunition. All equipment and ammunition will be provided!
