## Directions to Camp

Whiskey Springs Ranch  
47900 CR 70  
Crook, CO 80726

The property is located north of Jumbo Res. From Interstate 76, Take Exit 149 and drive North to Crook, CO on US Highway 55. At the stop sign in Crook, turn east (right) and drive 6 miles on US Hwy 138 to Logan County Road (LCR) 93. Turn north (left) and drive 3.5 miles to LCR 70. Turn east (right) and drive 1.5 miles to a private road on the north side of the road. Turn north (left) and drive straight north and pass under the Whiskey Springs Ranch sign. The event will take place north of the residence complex. Follow the road around the house to the east and continue north down into the creek bottom. Once past the creek, take a left at the fork and follow it to the camping area, approximately ¼ mile.
