1. So ... you want to learn to shoot!

Maybe you just completed your Hunter Safety certification classes, maybe you want to learn new shooting skills ... Maybe you just want to have some fun with your friends or want to meet new friends with your interest in the outdoors and shooting. 4-H may be just the thing you are looking for!

4-H goes way beyond "cows and cooking" ... we guide you on how to become a better person and a better citizen through the knowledge and the discipline you learn while having fun doing a variety of projects.

4-H Shooting Sports is one of those projects! Imagine learning how to shoot a shotgun or a bow or a muzzleloader. Imagine learning new outdoor skills with your friends by your side. Does this sound like what you're after? If so ... read on! 4-H may be in your future!

2. What we do ...

4-H Shooting Sports is divided into several "disciplines" where you learn skills and techniques particular to that discipline. Our disciplines are:

- ?? Shotgun (trap, skeet, sporting clays)
- ?? Air Rifle and Air Pistol
- ?? .22 Rifle
- ?? Muzzleloading (Black Powder)
- ?? Archery
- ?? Outdoor Skills (camping, hunting)

While learning your new shooting skills, you will be guided by trained and certified adult volunteers who know how to teach you the skills you need to know in order to be safe and successful!

You will have opportunities to demonstrate your new shooting ability at local, regional and state wide shooting events. You will have opportunities to learn how to speak to others about your new skills and learn how to record your successes and goals. You may even have opportunities to show your new knowledge at local county fairs and the Colorado State Fair!

Still sounds good? Maybe you should join 4-H!



3. How to Join 4-H Shooting Sports ...

Your first step is to visit with your parents (or those who take care of you) about joining 4-H. If they agree, the next step is to call your local Colorado State University Extension, 4-H Program Agent.

The 4-H Program is offered in a variety of ways in order to suit you and your families' needs. You can join a "community" 4-H club, a project specific 4-H club or even participate as an "independent" 4-H member.

As with all 4-H activities, 4-H Shooting Sports is a family project. As a family, you decide how much you can devote to this activity. How much you participate is up to you and your family.

The sky is the limit !

4. Adult Helpers leading youth ...

The 4-H Program has a long history of utilizing the ability and talents of adults, just like you, in order to teach our youth the skills they need to be better people and more productive and active citizens.

Put your shooting or outdoors knowledge to work by becoming a certified 4-H Shooting Sports Volunteer Leader.

The time it takes to become certified in a 4-H Shooting Sports discipline is more than offset by the skills you will then be able to pass along to our next generation of shooters!
