

2009 MUZZLELOADING OPEN CLASS SCORING GUIDELINES

All Paper Targets will be scored by the ½ ball rule. When ½ the projectile's diameter is in a scoring ring or bottle you will receive that score.

Juniors,

Will shoot the RB50-6-8 target, the top left bull which is the sighter bull.

They will also shoot the TG-2427 Bottle target skipping the top bottle.

The point values on the TG-2427 Bottle target are 10 points for hitting the neck,

And 5 points for hitting the body as long as ½ the projectile's diameter is in the area.

There are no other point values given.

Seniors,

Will shoot the RB100-8 target.

They will also shoot the TG-2427 Bottle target with the top bottle as their sighter target.

The point values on the TG-2427 Bottle target are 10 points for hitting the neck,

And 5 points for hitting the body as long as ½ the projectile's diameter is in the area.

There are no other point values given.
