

## General Shooter Responsibilities

1. Follow all Range Rules as posted.
2. Obey all verbal instructions of the line officer or RSO.
3. Ensure range is clear before shooting.
4. Ensure the range is safe before going down range.
5. Cooperate with other shooters.
6. Ensure you wear eye and ear protection while on the range.
7. Do not handle firearms when people are down range.
8. When not firing, your firearm will be made safe, unloaded and with the action open.
9. The muzzle of the firearm shall always be pointed in a safe direction.
10. Each shot will be an aimed, controlled shot.
11. Parents who bring young children are responsible for keeping them under their immediate and direct supervision at all times.
12. All shooters must check in with the line officer or RSO before going on the line.
13. Shooters will conduct themselves according to the Colorado 4-H Code of Conduct at all times and will be responsible for the conduct of any guests they bring.
14. All shooters are responsible for their firearms and ammunition while at the range.
15. Firearms that are out of the case and on the firing line will be made safe and have actions open and facing up, chambers empty, muzzles pointing down range and safeties on.
16. Only load firearms on the firing line after the line officer or RSO has given the command to load.
17. Do not point firearms at anything other than authorized targets.
18. Fire only at your own target.
19. Give the command "CEASE FIRE" if an unsafe condition exists.
20. Assist in policing the area of brass and any other debris.
21. For their safety, pets must be under control at all times.
22. For the duration of the shoot, DO NOT CLIMB ON THE BERMS.
23. Never fool around or indulge in horseplay on the range.
